**A Resolution Regarding Annual Senior Class Gifts**

**WHEREAS** it is fitting that each graduating class should leave a decent physical reminder of its presence as part of its legacy to future students of this university, and

**WHEREAS** it is also fitting that such reminders should additionally aid in the beautification of this university's campus, a process that has been undertaken at many other universities, and

**WHEREAS** this body has come to the conclusion that such projects on this campus should be funded using a designated portion of the graduation fee in a manner similar to that used to fund the bricks on the Walk of Honor, and

**WHEREAS** it is intended that the appropriate members of this university's administration shall draw up a list of beautification projects each year, and that the seniors shall vote during the Fall Elections on which project is to be funded as that year's class gift, therefore

**BE IT RESOLVED** that the Student Government Association hereby petitions the appropriate persons in the University administration to levy, as part of those fees necessary for graduation, a nominal fee of no more than twenty dollars (\$20) to be dedicated towards a yearly class gift.
