Referendum

Whereas The University of Louisiana at Lafayette is a major Research II University and students deserve adequate health care services comparable to other universities.

And Whereas Over 14, 000 students currently use the Health Services at UL Lafayette, paying \$20.00 a semester for both on and off campus students.

And Whereas There has been an increase in the utilization of the services provided by Student Health Services which is causing a severe strain on the staff.

And Whereas In order to meet the growing demand, additional nurses and part time physicians are needed to continue the service provided by Student Health Services.

And Whereas Services for Students with Disabilities needs a full-time Supported Education Counselor.

And Whereas All fees will be used exclusively for the administration and operation of services rendered by the UL Lafayette Student Health Service Department and Office of Students for Services with Disabilities.

Be It Therefore Enacted that the question be posed to the students on the Spring 2006 ballot "Should the students of the University of Louisiana at Lafayette who carry 6 or more credit hours per semester (Fall or Spring) or 3 or more credit hours (Summer) pay an additional \$5.00 Student Health Services fee in the fall, spring and summer semesters to maintain the operation of UL Lafayette Student Health Services which office will provide support for the Office of Services for Students with Disabilities. Effective Fall 2006 semester?"
